Alberto Tesi was born in Lamporecchio, Italy, on 5.5.1957.

He received the Laurea degree in Electronics Engineering from the University of Florence, in 1984, and the Ph.D. degree in Systems Engineering from the University of Bologna, in 1989.

Dr. Tesi joined the University of Florence in 1990, as a research assistant. Currently, he is a Professor of Control Systems at the Department of Information Engineering of the same University. He taught courses on systems analysis and control, he has been advisor of many graduate and PhD students.

Dr. Tesi was Dean of the Faculty of Engineering from 1.11.2006 to 31.10.2009. He was Rector of the University of Florence from 1.11.2009 to 31.10.2015.

Dr. Tesi served as the Secretary General of the Conference of the Italian University Rectors (CRUI) from 18.09.2013 to 31.10.2015.

Dr. Tesi was a member of the Research Policy Working Group (RPWG) of the European University Association (EUA) and he is currently a member of the Nomination Committee of the same association.

Dr. Tesi was associate editor of the IEEE Transactions on Circuits and Systems (1994-1995), IEEE Transactions on Automatic Control (1995-1998) and Systems and Control Letters (1995-2010). He was member of the conference editorial board of the Conference on Decision and Control (1994-1999) and the American Control Conference (1995-2000).

He was member of the Policy Committee of the International Federation of Automatic Control (IFAC) (2008-2011).

The main scientific interests of Dr. Tesi are in the field of systems analysis and control, with emphasis on complex dynamics, robustness and performance optimization of control systems.

Dr. Tesi is author of about 180 publications in referenced international journals and conferences, along with the following bibliometric indicators: h-index = 36 (Google scholar); h-index = 26 (Scopus); h-index = 25 (Web of Science).
